AUDIENCE PIECES

Headshots

"As you know, we sometimes do sketches here on Conan. And when we do, we put out a call to agents who send us headshots based on the roles we're trying to fill. Since we have a sketch coming up next week, we thought we'd share with you the headshots we received for each role."

The camera zooms in on audience members, freeze-frames their head and borders it like a headshot, then puts a name underneath it. Descriptions are read and match with the audience.

- Country veterinarian. (Older, gentle-looking guy. Show name "Barney Willard.")

- Small-town public librarian. (Aunt Bea-looking woman. Show name "Nell Applebee.")

- High school librarian. (Sexy woman. Show name "Francesca Statutory-Cougar.")

- Ex-football captain, current wife-beater. (Lumberjacklooking guy. Show name "Brock Notwoke.")

- Alabama drifter who's stolen a car and has a kidnapped rodeo clown in the trunk. (Creepy-looking guy. Show name "Bones Braker.")

Rodeo clown. (Andy Richter. Show name "Andrew Richter.")
Drifter's kombucha-bootlegging friend. (Nervous looking hippie guy. Show name "Cheech N. Chong.")

Irish Back model (like a hand model, but just her back) with trampstamps of the drifter, his friend, and the clown on her back. (Camera close-up comes from behind audience to show freckled woman's naked back, Photoshopped with the 3 trampstamps - clown's is just his big clownfeet sticking out of a closed car trunk. Show name "Ann O'Nymous.")
Insane, escaped mental patient (Close-up freeze-frame on Conan. Show name "Colin O'Brian" [named misspelled].)

Finish The Cheer

Conan goes up to preselected audience members who tell him things about their lives. Where they're from, marriage, hobbies, etc. The Conan O'Brien Cheerleading Squad[™] (middle-aged, unshaven men with pot bellies who are wearing tank tops and tiny, shiny shorts) then goes up and down the aisle dancing and waving pompoms singing a cheer about the member. But they leave the last line unfinished (with an open rhyming word that could be guessed). After the audience member guesses the last line wrong, the cheerleaders finish the cheer. The final cheer is always about Conan.

COCS final line: A freaky big toe . . . that pretends not to know . . . that faux Thoreau schmo . . . James Franco. (Shot of her foot, then a shot of an enamored James Franco sitting in the audience staring at her foot. The foot then slowly turns away.)

Conan, Conan. He's our man. If he can't do it, . . . Conan happily guesses: "Nobody can?" COCS final line: HE PASTY! HE PASTY! HE PASTY! HE PASTY! (Conan does a furious reaction shot which is frozen on the screen.)

FIELD PIECES

James Corden Umpires A Beer League Softball Game

Corden says that he was never much for playing ball when he was younger because it's not really a British thing, and his Dad was too busy just working around the yard to play with him much anyway. But he just discovered adult beer softball leagues, and they look fun. He's a little too old to play now, but he's not too old to umpire and drink beer. Cut to him showing up at home plate in a tuxedo and top hat, already drinking beer as he meets with the other umpires. He asks them the most basic questions about the game, like what's a bat and how does a run score? When he's told there are 3 outs, he asks if that means that everyone else is still in the closet. He eventually gets into arguments with the other umps about rules and their ability, and this continues throughout the game.

Since it's a softball league, he's constantly drinking beers. As he gets drunker, he starts sort of playing the

game as a player. He slides into bases (camera shows him sliding in from one side and the runner sliding in from another). He grabs the ball and tags a runner but still calls him safe because "I missed the tag." He asks for an instant replay, and when told they don't have that, he looks at a video on his phone of the movie "Field of Dreams." It's the moment when Kevin Costner says "Hey Dad, you wanna have a catch?" The camera then cuts back to Corden with buckets of tears running down his face.

Corden starts arguments with managers, chest-bumping the manager, throwing his hat and kicking dirt on the plate. When a ball is hit out of play (either a homer or a foul over the backstop), he reaches into his ballbag and pulls out a donut and eats it.

The segment ends with him passed out drunk on the ground at home plate and all the players and managers covering him up by kicking dirt on him. They leave, he comes to, shakes off some of the dirt, and says faintly, "Hey Dad, you wanna have a catch?" His Dad (played by Corden made up to look old) then pours a wheelbarrow full of dirt on him.

Cousin Sal Goes To A Homebrew Convention

Cousin Sal starts off by explaining that homebrew and micro-breweries are big business nowadays. At least as big as an industry can be that's run by boring and pretentious alcoholics. He walks the floor and visits a lot of the booths, sampling the beers. He carries a white rhino horn to drink out of, because "When I go beer pompous, I go endangered species beer pompous." He insults the brewers by making faces and pretentiously saying things like "This beer is as subtle as a kick in the crotch with steel-toed boots.", "It has the suggestive aroma of a bus driver's seat with just a flutter of Target-brand dog shampoo.", and "This would pair well with Cheez Whiz", as he sprays Cheez Whiz on top of the beer and drinks/eats it.

He makes his way over to his own booth, where he has his own beer on display. In flashback, we see that he's just rebottled Miller Lite with a new hipster-looking label. His brew table has rusty tubs, dirty bottles, and for some reason, rolls and rolls of hospital gauze on it. In the background, there's a Health Inspection sign with an "F." Visual comes up that says SNARK WEEK with running, bloody type font, and a swimming shark giving side-eye.

Conan and Andy then watch videos of sharks swimming around saying snarky things. Conan and Andy do reaction type lines like "That's not nice" and "Why are they being so mean?"

The stock video shows the sharks sort of swimming up to one another then swimming away as they talk. They insult: - Celebrities - "Guy Fieri dives down here with us? He doesn't need a shark tank. He's about as likely to get eaten as a meal at his Times Square restaurant." (Video of Guy Fieri in a shark tank.) "I've eaten truck tires and bags of medical waste, but you couldn't pay me enough to even nibble on Charlie Sheen." (Video of a shark throwing up.)

- Fashion - "Ah, girlfriend, unless you're heading back to prison, which wouldn't be a big surprise, you might want to rethink the horizontal stripes" (as a striped shark swims by).

- Other sharks - "Oh great, here comes that slut, Khloe. She's not fooling anyone with that lip filler." (Video of a shark with big lips.) "Next time maybe brush your teeth if you want to keep a real hammerhead."(Khloe shark has all sorts of food in its mouth.)

- Sharks look into the camera as though they're looking at Conan and start to insult him. "Oh wow, it's Conan O'Brien. His show's on some trucker CB channel now, isn't it? People think we never get any sun down here, but that is one pastyass white boy. Come on, let's go see who's on Fallon tonight". Then every shark quickly swims away.

Conan is in the middle of his monologue when his Director says off-screen that they have to stop taping because there's a car on fire in the parking lot. They cut to the lot, where a beat-up old Pinto is on fire. Andy laughs and says "What loser would ever drive that piece of junk?" right as Conan yells out, "That's my car!" and runs off the stage.

About 2 seconds later, entering from the other side of the stage comes Conan with his hair parted on the other side and wearing an old-time villain's moustache. (This is not played as Conan in disguise, but as a different character.) Andy says, "Oh God no, it's Conan's evil twin, Moanin' O'Brien." Moanin' is carrying a gas can and a lighter. He then insults that night's guests, Andy, the band, the audience, and especially Conan. He runs over to Conan's desk and douses it with gas, as the Director shouts "Go to commercial" off-screen and Moanin' is wrestled away.

Conan comes back after the commercial break, mentions that his desk feels wet and smells odd, but continues on with the show. As he signs off at the end of the show, he puts his feet up, leans back, lights a cigar, and tosses the match down. There is then stock footage of a nuclear bomb explosion as credits roll.

NUN Quién carajo le importa? ("Carajo" is bleeped out with a mariachi band note of music.) (English subtitle) Who the English-music-bleep cares? (Subtitle actually says "English-music-bleep".) (Jimmy again smiles.) JIMMY (Fumbles through the book,
